





The Grand Jury charges that on or about March 22, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed a controlled substance that is

classified as a Schedule I or II, which is a narcotic drug; a controlled substance analogue; **Methamphetamine**; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers, and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers, or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 3-4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about March 22, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant recklessly, with a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument, or intentionally causes or attempts to cause physical injury to: a state, county, city, or federal peace officer; healthcare provider as defined in KRS 311.821, if the event occurs while the healthcare provider is providing medical care in an emergency room of a hospital; paid or volunteer emergency medical services personnel certified or licensed pursuant to KRS Chapter 311Am if the event occurs while personnel are performing job-related duties; a paid or volunteer member of an organized fire department, if the event occurs while the member is performing job-related duties; paid or volunteer rescue squad personnel affiliated with the Division of Emergency Management of the Department of Military Affairs or a local disaster and emergency services organization pursuant to KRS Chapter 39F, if the event occurs while personnel are performing job-related duties or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about March 22, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
