The Grand Jury charges: That on or about January 18, 2024, through February 9, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant is over the age of 21 and stood convicted of at least two felonies after his 18th birthday OR one (1) or more felony sex crimes against a minor as defined in KRS 17.500, and now stands convicted of any one (1) or more felonies. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
