COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 27, 2025, at approximately 03:07, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully introduced a vape containing THC, same being dangerous contraband, into the Adair County Regional Jail, or being a person confined in the Adair County Regional Jail, he knowingly made, obtained, or possessed a vape containing THC, same being dangerous contraband, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 27, 2025, at approximately 23:52, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully introduced alprazolam and buprenorphine, same being dangerous contraband, into the Adair County Regional Jail, or being a person confined in the Adair County Regional Jail, he knowingly made, obtained, or possessed alprazolam and buprenorphine, same being dangerous contraband, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 27, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed alprazolam, a Schedule IV controlled substance, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 27, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree, when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed buprenorphine, a Schedule III narcotic, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 27, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed offense of Promoting Contraband in the First Degree, two (2) counts, in violation of KRS 520.050, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were

committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 27, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of March 27, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 27, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
