
The Grand Jury charges that on or about June 4, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 2-3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 6, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he/she wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.
