Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly bought, sold, offered for sale, or received, or had in his possession, any titled motor vehicle or trailer or component part thereof, from which the original manufacturer's vehicle identification number, or serial number, has been removed, defaced, altered, obscured or destroyed, unless such vehicle or component part has attached thereto an identification number assigned or approved by the Department of Vehicle Regulation under the provisions of KRS 186.1911 or authorized agency of another state in lieu of the manufacturer's number or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operator of any vehicle upon a highway shall operate the vehicle in a careful manner, with regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway. No person shall willfully operate any vehicle on any highway in such a manner as to injure the highway aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant Disregarded traffic control device also known as traffic light or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 12:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant the operator of any vehicle when upon a highway shall travel upon the right side of the highway whenever possible, and unless the left side of the highway is clear of all other traffic or obstructions for a sufficient distance ahead to permit the overtaking and passing of another vehicle to be completed without interfering with the operation of any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction or any vehicle being overtaken. The overtaking vehicle shall return to the proper traffic lane as soon as practicable and, if the passing vehicle enters the oncoming traffic lane, before coming within two hundred (200) feet of any approaching vehicle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 13:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to indicate the intention to turn right or left shall be given continuously for not less than the last one hundred feet (100) feet traveled by the motor vehicle before the turn or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 14:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant shall pass to the left of them and shall not again drive to the right until reasonably clear of those vehicles or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 15:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant No vehicle shall be driven on the left side of the roadway under the following conditions: (a) When approaching or upon the crest of a grade or a curve in the highway where the operator's view is obstructed within such distance as to create a hazard in the event another vehicle might approach from the opposite direction; (b) When approaching within one hundred (100) feet of or traversing any intersection or railroad grade crossing; (c) When the view is obstructed upon approaching within one hundred (100) feet of any bridge, viaduct or tunnel. (2) The foregoing limitations shall not apply upon a one (1) way roadway, nor when an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the highway; provided, any person so doing shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed portion of the highway within such distance as to constitute an immediate hazard, nor to the operator of a vehicle turning left into or from an alley, private road or driveway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 16:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to have registration plate conspicuously upon the rear of the motor vehicle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 17:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to produce written proof in the form of an insurance card that the insured has in effect an insurance contract providing security in conformity with this subtitle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 18:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed while operating a motor vehicle, motorcycle, or moped upon a highway, secured an operator's license or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 19:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 28, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant improperly displayed the registration plate or aided, abetted, or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.


