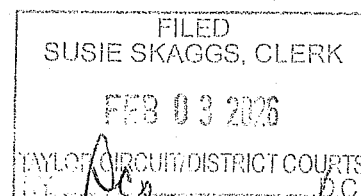

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 5, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed a controlled substance that is classified as a Schedule I or II, which is a narcotic drug; a controlled substance analogue; Methamphetamine; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers, and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers, or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 5, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 5, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 5, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear a seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted, or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



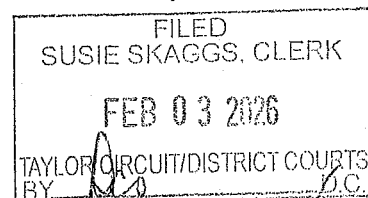

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully was trafficking, in Four (4) grams or more of **cocaine**; Two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine; ten (10) or more dosage units of a controlled substance that is classified in schedules I or II and is a narcotic drug, or a controlled substance analogue; an quantity of heroin, fentanyl, carfentanil, or fentanyl derivatives; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers or any quantity of a controlled substance specified in paragraph (a) (b) or (c) of this subsection in an amount less than the amounts specified in those paragraphs or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 11, 2025 in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed a controlled substance that is classified as a Schedule I or II, which is a narcotic drug; a controlled substance analogue; Methamphetamine; **Fentanyl**; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers, and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers, or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully traffics in: Twenty (20) or more dosage unties of a controlled substance classified in Schedules IV or V; or any quantity of a controlled substance specified in paragraphs (a) of this subsection in an amount less that the amount specified in that paragraph or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. **2nd Offense**

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he or she has such right, he or she: intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys, or damages any property causing pecuniary loss of less than five hundred dollars (\$500); or As a tenant, intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys, or damages residential rental property causing pecuniary loss of less than five hundred dollars (\$500) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant to whom or for whose use any controlled substance has been prescribed, sold or dispensed, by a practitioner or other person authorized under this chapter, may lawfully possess it only in the container in which it was delivered to him/her by the person selling or dispensing the same or abetted or counseled with another in commission of said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed marijuana or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Creating fear of death or serious physical injury among students, parents, or school personnel; (c) Makes false statements that he or she has placed a weapon of mass destruction at any location other than one specified in KRS 508.075; or (d) Without lawful authority places a counterfeit weapon of mass destruction at any location other than one specified in KRS 508.075 or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 24, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possesses a controlled substance that is classified in schedules I or II and is a narcotic drug; a controlled substance analogue; **methamphetamine**; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers, and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



COUNT 2:


