Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



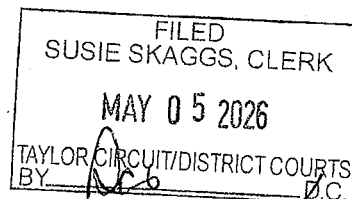


